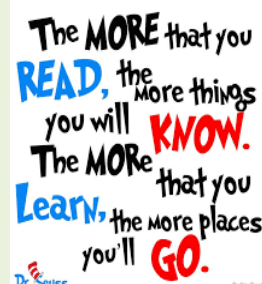

Circles and Squares have been looking at shapes and repeated patterns this week, building houses with magnets, blocks, and drawings.

Orange Class have enjoyed coding in ICT this week! In science, they spent time on the playground investigating and discussing how we make and hear sounds.
