Red Classes have been talking about the new decade. They talked about celebrations and how we celebrate the start of a new year.

Children in Orange Class have been learning lots of different strategies to help them with their addition and subtraction calculations. They used lots of practical resources to help.

Year 2 have started the term by reading the book The Necklace of Raindrops. They acted out the story, told it aloud and wrote their own versions – what a busy week!

Year 3 have begun their new class book this week, The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. In Science they have been looking at light sources, and exploring what is and isn't a source of light.

Year 4 have been practicing their times tables using songs. They've also been working on a piece of writing using exciting words to describe their best day over Christmas.

In English this week, Year 5 have been looking at the advert Coming Home about a Robin. They've talked about its feelings and written five sentence stories around it.

During their art lessons this week Year 6 have been using the tonking method to paint backgrounds for the Circle of Life art work, that links in to their Science lessons.

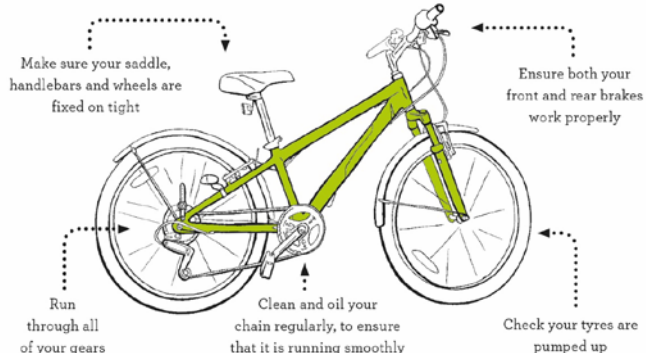
