Essex Local Authority will be running their Local Offer Roadshows for parents/carers who have children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) later this term.

The event for the North East Area will be on **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> March** at **Colchester United Football Stadium.** 

Your do not need any diagnosis to go along and get help at a roadshow. You may:

- be new to SEND and unsure what help is available
- feel your child needs help or have questions about the support they already receive
- want to find out what support there is for you as a parent or carer
- not be sure what support you might need

There are many different professionals who can help you under one roof. This includes local support groups, education professionals, health teams and social care teams.

You will be able to:

- access support and information
- understand the different services available
- find out about support available in schools
- find out about local support, such as parent groups
- meet other carers and parents

You can drop in when it's convenient for you, without booking. Groups and teams will have their own stalls. You can explore the different stalls, ask questions and have a cuppa. Quieter areas for discussion will also be available.
